The Life Center Shelter is collaborating with Delco Project Share to provide programming for shelter residents. Delco Project Share is a program from Mental Health Partnerships. Delco Project Share visited the Life Center to provide information to the residents about the services they have to offer (Computer Lab, Financial Literacy classes, Employment Supports, Resume Writing, etc.). Recent Development Activity

CAADC has been fortunate to receive the following private contributions from the community during the last quarter: CAADC received \$1,250 from the Delaware County Medical Society for Agency support. Marple Presbyterian Church donated \$500 to CAADC. W.W. Smith Charitable Trust provided a grant of \$10,000 for furniture support for clients.
